### HOW TO PAY YOUR BILL....

Having a hard time remembering to pay your bill on a monthly basis? We can help! The Village has more than one option to pay your bills.

- Drop off post-dated cheques. The Village will automatically process these cheques. (These cheques can be for both utilities and taxes.)
- Switch to annual billing. With annual billing you can pay once for the entire year. (There is no cost savings by paying monthly or annually.) Yearly accounts are billed in February and due March 31.
- Pay by interact e-transfer through online banking. Please contact the Village Office for more information on e-transfer requirements.

### **MONTHLY TAX PAYMENTS**

Would you like to pay your taxes monthly? Here's how:

- 1. From your 2020 Tax Notice: Divide the total 2020 tax amount by 12.
- 2. Write 6 cheques for the amount calculated, date one for each month (January to June) for any day of your choosing. (This is essentially pre-paying your taxes for half a
- 3. Drop off the cheques at the Village Office.

What happens next:

- 4. The cheques will be processed on the date written and deposited with the next regular
- 5. When your 2021 Tax Notice is received complete the above process using the total 2021 cheques for July to December.

Why this is a good option:

- You are able to better budget monthly for tax payments.
- As long as you have been making monthly payments you will not be charged penalties of each year.
- You will have completely paid your taxes by December 31st of each year so will not be a

Please note: You may make the cheques out for any amount of your choosing, however, ar December 31st will be charged penalties. If you choose to combine your monthly tax payme payment, please indicate this on your cheques. The Village will automatically use the cheques. utility amount and then pay the remaining amount to taxes.
